

Drop Off Bin Recycling

Recycle Right, Recycle Now

When in doubt, leave it out – if you are unsure if an item is recyclable in the Drop Off Recycling bins, the best course of action is to leave it out and throw it in your regular trash. You can contact KNPLCB for questions at 308.534.8100.

ONLY #1 and #2 plastics accepted.

Shredded paper can be recycled if it is tied tightly in a separated bag – no loose shredded paper.

All bottles, milk jugs, tin cans must be empty – no liquids accepted.

These items are **PROHIBITED**: When unacceptable items end up in the recycling stream, it can contaminate the entire bin. Please respect the service and others who take the time to recycle right.

Styrofoam – empty cardboard boxes from any packaging

Glass

Lids – none accepted on water bottles, milk jugs, soda bottles, etc

Straws, Reusable plates, Kleenex, Paper Towels, Plastic Utensils

Diapers

Clothes, shoes, sheets

Furniture, Chairs, Chair Pads

Hazardous Waste – i.e.: paint, thinner, electronics, oil, fuel

Dog/Cat Food Bags

Vacuum Bags

Dryer Lint

Bathroom Trash - Q-tips, cotton balls, tampon applicators, razors, hair, tampons, or pads

Nuts, Bolts, Shelving

Construction Material – Lumber, pallets, shingles, siding

Chip/Snack bags

Insulation

Carpet

Aerosol Cans

Cigarette packages/butts
